Pete's Place

This month we will bring you up to date on the status of the Nationals and the outlook for 1996.

Over the weekend of May 20 and 21 representatives of the SIGs and the event and category directors met with the guy who is actually getting the work done on the site to assure that the goals of all the interests would be met. Friday was devoted to the issues involved with the 1995 Nats and making sure that all were familiar with the physical layout of the site as it now exists in preparation for Saturday's discussion of the 1996 NATS.

If you have not been there here is what we have. There are about 1000 acres of rolling farm land on which there are several buildings and the AMA office building and Museum. One of the original buildings near the new one story office and museum building is known as the white house , which of course it is, and it is used to hold meetings and house the site coordinator. Out on the acreage, the access to which is controlled with a gate and an attendant booth there is a hard surface road which winds to an L shaped pad with parking, covered pit area and control tower which houses the clothespin takeaway type frequency control. This area is now being used for R/C when the facility is not being used for some scheduled event which would conflict. This area will be used for U-Control when stage center, the new runway system, is built some distance to the South.

Much as last year, the area had been subjected to some very heavy rains just before we all got there but there were a couple of heavy duty machines on site ready to start grading and digging on the Monday we left. The site coordinator expected to have stage

center ready by July for the World Championship pylon races which will be held there this summer. The runways, which will be in the shape of a flattened X, will be 75 feet wide and 700 feet long with a 100 by 100 foot rectangle at the junction which will allow takeoffs into the wind regardless of the direction the course is oriented.

You might be interested to know that the site coordinator is none other than our own Gary Hover, so you can rest assured that our racing interests are being protected. I understand that they are already calling the runway layout the Gary Hover memorial. Something about pylon prevailing winds vs pattern sun location. It is great to know that all the dealings with the work crews and the engineering will be handled by someone who understands the needs of the modelers. Either Gary is a candidate for Sainthood to reside in the hot humid midwest or he has some advance warning that California is about to become an island. If nothing else, we will all benefit greatly and Gary will get a stern reminder of why it was that he chose to live in Visalia.

96 AMA Nationals

On Saturday, all the interested parties were on site and we started the wheels in motion to work out the 1996 Nationals which will be held on the National Flying Site. To accomplish that goal we all knew that there would have to be some changes in the way things had been organized in the past. All the special interest groups got an opportunity to air their needs and various combinations of events were explored to find the best utilization of the site. From racing's point of view, I can't see how we could have fared better. We will share the site for a week with control line events and helicopter. As it stands now we will process on Sunday July 7 for all racing events and

start racing on Monday. The format will be different from that used in the past in that we will race two events each day. This will give us an additional day of racing for the three major events which will allow some time for repairs and in addition we will get some additional racing hours in all three events. As it stands now Q500 will race 4 half days, F1, 3 and QM40, 2.

Wayne Yeager has done a great job in holding out for what he deemed to be the best for racing and we owe him a great deal for all the time and effort he puts in. While all that was going on there have been a couple of other things going on you should know about.

Rules Proposals

You may have noticed that those involved in the rules process haven't been too happy with the present system, too slow ,too hard to edit prospective rules changes etc. The AMA has now scheduled a meeting of the chairpersons of the Contest Board and the Executive Council for the Fall to consider changes in the present system. Unfortunately, perhaps, they have asked the contest board members to edit the wording of the present document where what may be needed is a more comprehensive rethink of the basic system. I encourage you all to talk with your AMA VP and your contest board member. They can use all the input you can give them. If you don't, you will deserve what ever happens.

95 NMPRA Championship

Ron Schorr tells me that the plans for the championships are coming along great. For those of you with a sense of history we are going back to the Sepulveda Basin site where we had the first championship 24 years ago on a site so new that the blacktop was soft enough so that the chair legs sank

Letters to the Editor

I was watching car racing on TV yesterday and had an idea. It started with noticing that there had been a NASCAR truck race in Portland and I didn't realize that there was a NASCAR event of this stature anywhere in the area.

This spawned a thought closer to our interests. Most NMPRA districts must have a site and an event that is outstanding in their area, or has the potential to be a very special racing event. Now, I recognize that not all districts are as active in my passion, Formula 1, but every district does have active participation in a racing event. I am assuming that every district has at least one potential event that could be promoted to be a *National event*.

Each district would have first date choice for their #1 event. The weather in the different districts will help keep the events spread out over the year. We already have, in my opinion four national Formula 1 events. In normal schedule date order, they are Phoenix, Las Vegas, the Nats and the NMPRA championship race. In district 2 we have more than one race site that could be a national event, but our race at Arlington, WA is already of national quality in both site and help. The folks in district 6 are working on making their Chicopee race an event. They talked about a lobster feed to go with the race, sounds good to me. There is also a group that is working hard to build a new site dedicated to racing.

There is a lot of racing all over the country that goes unrecognized. I know there is lots of premier racing happening, that goes by unrecognized because of no publicity and conflicts in race scheduling. For example, I know there is a big Quarter 40 race scheduled in district 8 on Sept. 16-17. We also have a local race in district 2 the same weekend and most of us will support a local race first. If a National race was scheduled and a local race scheduled anyway, then we could have a choice and not just pick the local event.

You have the idea of my thoughts. I have not ignored other districts. I have just picked some examples that I know about, and would hope this will spur some thinking and action with others and could help concentrate our national schedule and result in more participants in these premier events. Please remember, these events can be 421, 422, 424 or 428. These events would have to be run per the rule book, with no local rules or exceptions.

Another thought is national points for these events. Maybe these specific events should be counted as local races for national points. This should encourage more participation for these races.

Please check it out. This suggested venue may or may not be the proper way to accomplish more participation, but I feel that this concept has a lot of potential positives for our racing fraternity.
