Saturday & Sunday June 11th & 12th

Hillsdale Lake flying field – Hillsdale, KS

Racing Classes: AMA 424, 426 Q-500 & NMPRA EF-1 Electric

Course: 475.5' x 100' 3-Pole on Saturday and Sunday. EF1 will be flown on the 475' course. We will be using the Heartland Speed Freakz' light system for this race.

Events: 424 and 426 on Saturday, EF-1 and 426 on Sunday. 426 is two separate 1-day races, so if you can only make one day, come on out and race, you won't be missing out. We hope to have a raffle prize similar to the 2015 race, details at a later date.

About AMA 424:

AMA Event 424 Q-500 rules are used on the AMA Short Course. Planes are limited to balsa/foam wing construction, hollow molded composite wing and tails are not allowed. APC 9x6 will be provided for each entrant.

About AMA 426:

AMA Event 426 Q-500 uses the Event 426 rules with the Sport Jett engine available from www.dubjett.com. Hollow molded composite wing and tails are allowed in this class.

There you can find the list of approved planes, motors, etc. APC 8x8e props will be provided for each entrant. **One exception – the E-Flite Pogo will be allowed to compete even without the add-on wingtips the NMPRA requires.** If you still have a Pogo, bring it out! Also, as we land on grass runways (plywood for takeoffs) wheel pants on planes not required.

The R/C Barnstormers field is located just south of the dam at Hillsdale Lake in Hillsdale State Park.

From Highway 169

Take HWY 169 south from the intersection of I-35 and 151st Street in Olathe or north from Paola, KS. Exit at the Hillsdale lake exit at 255th Street. Turn west and drive through the town of Hillsdale. At the four-way stop, continue straight ahead. After crossing the dam, take the first gravel road on the left. At the bottom of the hill, turn right; the gate for the flying field is on the left.

From the Southwest

Take Interstate 35 North from Emporia. In Ottawa, KS, exit at Highway 68 (exit 187) Turn right and drive approximately 16 miles. Turn left on Osawatomie Road. Continue until reaching the Hillsdale Lake Dam. Just prior to the dam, take a right on the gravel road. At the bottom of the hill turn right; the gate for the flying field in on the left.

NOTE: A park vehicle permit is required for all vehicles entering the flying field. Visit the Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks [Hillsdale Lake](#) Web Site for more information. There is a self-pay station as you turn onto the road to our field, and we should have some day permit pay envelopes with us at registration.
