NMPRA Matrix Software Modernization – Project Update

Over the past several months I have worked with the rest of the Matrix Software Committee to define areas for improvement in Paul Herman's matrix software. This is the software program that is used by many of the NMPRA clubs. Once the primary areas were defined, I began the process of working on the code. We decided that, due to the wide use of Paul's code. it would be best to stay with the overall code for best adoption rather than completely re-invent the wheel. Further, we are working towards the goal of releasing a working version to NMPRA clubs by early October of this year. Modernization of Paul's existing software will give us the best chance of achieving the goal.

The first step was to bring the code forward to modern software tools, as the compiler originally used was out of date. Employing modern coding tools helps tremendously in debugging and code maintenance. Fortunately, the import went fairly smoothly, with most features requiring no repairs. I broke the desired code changes into two categories: 1) Technical matrix improvements to the lane allocation and to the matrix rolling, and 2) User interface and usability improvements. For the Nats, I am focused on the first area and will utilize the improved tool to build the Nats matrices. I will work the user interface issues for the Champ Race and tool deployment.

Work to date has focused on matrix building steps that include the lane allocation and the matrix rolling. In addition, some new features have been incorporated:

In 3-lane races, the byes are preferentially put in lane 2, so that planned 2-man races start on the same flag.

A strong preference is put on placing all byes in the same lane, so bye vs. bye does not occur.

A mechanism is used to support auto leveling of pilot skill. A manual approach was used by some large races; this tool will reduce the work load.

Significant randomization is used to improve matrix allocation without auto-leveling.

A CD may designate a "lane 1 affinity" for himself, which helps in running a contest. This does not affect lane allocations, but rather swaps entire lanes after allocations.

Matrix rolling also has some improvements:

Back-to-back heats are virtually eliminated except in the very smallest races (3 or 4 rows, just cannot be avoided).

Duplicate pairings are delayed as long as possible.

Duplicate triplets are virtually eliminated.

When a pairing does duplicate, back-to-back rounds with such duplicates are avoided. In other words, if I raced Jim in round 5, I may have to race him again, but it won't be in round 6.

Add a Round" button will be implemented.

Finally, before the Nats I plan to implement a CSV file import and export function. This tool will allow direct input of a properly formatted excel file, rather than having to re-type everything in the tool. The big race CD's will love this! Further, export of results has two purposes. For the Nats, I'll be able to export the results from A and B matrices, then combine the top entries into one CSV and reimport to make the finals matrix! Another aspect will be a future ability to import a results file into the standings spreadsheet, reducing the work load on the standings tabulators and reducing the chance of errors.

This first round of improvements for the alpha prototype may not have a sexy look and feel, but should result in noticeable improvements in the matrix structure at the Nats. After the Nats, I will review the priority list for the user interface improvements.







Tony Seymore (see pictures) flew the first time around pylons on Saturday, but prior had flown 424, 426, and 1/4 40 airplanes! Seems as if he is already hooked on pylon racing. Roger Burright has been racing for a few years in Wichita and went on to win 424 on Sunday. Mike Ryken was at his second race. Duane Hulen loaned him his 426 airplane, and he flew 426 Saturday and Sunday. The first time he flew a 426 was in the first heat Saturday. He was third in 424 Saturday and two seconds off the fast time in 424 on Sunday. He also had pretty respectable times in 426 both days. Duane says he's hooked. There were a lot of experienced racers testing their equipment and helping "new guys." At the end of Friday the start line at AMA site 3 was well oiled. A good sign of plenty of great practice. During one of our luncheons, Scott told me he is going to be sure he gets to race in 2016 since he has been too busy over the past several years with the other racing support functions. For relaxation, Scott additionally was an avid fisherman. He would fish



every chance he could for fun or in tournaments with his close friend and son-in-law, Josh.


District 9: Alejandro Vazquez




